





Bonny Hills Garden Centre needed an outdoor café that would provide a casual dining experience whilst maximising the garden setting and views over the reservoir to the south.

A simplified skillion roof form reaches towards the gardens, providing a visual cue upon entry. The café cantilevers the reservoir's embankment to the south, simulating a truly treetop dining experience, inclusive of a tranquil reservoir and bushland vista.

Locally sourced hardwood timbers dominate the interior, providing both warmth and a reflection of the natural

bushland setting. The Colorbond roof and ceiling give a crisp contrast to the timber, marrying the building with the existing garden centre.
